

SEND & Inclusive Learning Tiered Support

Select your tier of support and take advantage of access to additional resources. A higher-tier SLA offers significant advantages in terms of depth of support, resource availability and professional development opportunities.

It also ensures settings are well-prepared to meet statutory requirements and promote inclusive practices effectively. Investing in a higher tier can lead to better outcomes for all.

Tier 1 - support and Advice via Telephone/Email

Advantages of this tier includes the opportunity to access timely assistance and guidance from experienced professionals to support decision making or action.

This service provides reassurance to SENCOs and leaders, knowing that advice is readily available.

 - Written summaries ensure clarity of action points and provide a record for follow-up within school/setting or with the team
