## **Programmes of Support**



#### What we offer:

A comprehensive service of teaching advice, training and support to enable primary & special schools to deliver Modern Foreign Languages.

<u>Subject Reviews & Preparation for Inspections:</u> The programme will include identification of areas for development including MFL policy, action plans, the quality of provision and staff knowledge of the curriculum.

<u>Developing High Quality Teaching & Learning:</u> This programme, agreed with SLT, provides support packages for individual teachers to improve quality of teaching in MFL, identifies areas for development and provides recommendations on how to fulfil the statutory requirements for MFL.

<u>Professional Development:</u> A programme that encompasses training for all staff, phases or cohorts related to national and local developments and priorities, including bespoke language upskilling and methodology. This could be delivered by twilight sessions, staff meetings, and whole or half inset days.

<u>Developing MFL across the Curriculum:</u> A programme which includes an audit of provision, and supports the development of MFL in the curriculum, by both embedding it and using it as a tool for reinforcing other areas of learning.

<u>Developing Effective Assessment:</u> This programme, agreed with SLT, will include development of effective assessment tools, useful assessment information for transition to secondary and monitoring and evaluation of the impact of assessment tools.





<u>Developing Effective Transition:</u> The programme will focus on collaborative planning and the development of teaching and learning strategies to address identified priorities as well as opportunities to share good practice between schools.

<u>Support for Celebrations & Events:</u> A programme that provides advice on resources, delivery of MFL assemblies and support for language teachers with preparation of pupils for performance.

International Work / School Links: This programme provides support in achieving the British Council International Award, help in establishing and sustaining links abroad as well as ideas for joint curriculum projects with overseas partners.
