Early Reading

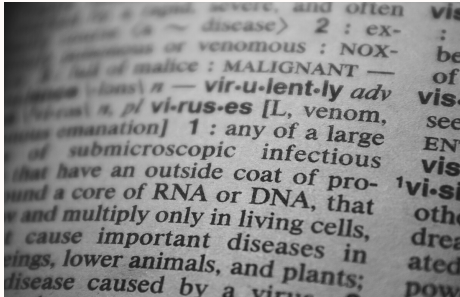
